

## **Prior Art**

- Motorola StarTac 3000 – A mobile phone released in January 1996. The mobile phone includes a choice of at least two service levels. Service level 1 is restricted so that the user can only dial the numbers in memory locations 1-10. Dialling from key pad, accessing memory and speed dial function are disabled. Service level 4 has no restrictions. An undated manual is available online at the link below. A copy of this manual published on or before 22 February 1996 is sought.
